Victory Hall

One of the many sadnesses created by the evil Covid virus has been the inability to have activities in the hall – especially communal meals – despite the Trustees conforming to all requirements with hand sanitisers etc.. They are pleased that the School has been able to continue using the Hall. During this period of the hall not being used otherwise the Trustees have been able to organise some improvements including the installation of a stairlift with funding from the Frieda Scott Charitable Trust. This will enable people in wheelchairs or those worried about ascending the rather fearsome stairs to participate in functions in the main room. Darren Barker has turned what was a rather depressing sight at the top of those stairs with peeling paint etc. into a very presentable area and has also improved the gentlemen's toilet area.

With the welcome help of a "Retail, Hospitality and Leisure Grant" from the nice Chancellor the Hall Trustees have managed to keep the hall running without any of the usual income since the "All day Breakfast" in March. They have still had to pay for cleaning, power and insurance. Structural work planned for this summer (with a grant from EDC) has been rescheduled for next spring.

By then we may be able to open up and have grand village lunch (or supper) for all of us to celebrate surviving the long dark period. Any ideas or suggestions about should be given to Gavin (see below) — well done the trustees!
