Stagecoach have said that with growing passenger numbers the service will continue through the autumn and winter. This is good news and Friends of Eden Valley Public Transport (FEVPT) thank those who have used the service. However to secure and possibly extend this, passenger numbers must continue to increase. So please keep using, or start to use the 563 buses. Remember that the 506 buses run from Appleby to Kendal via Penrith during Kendal College terms and tickets are interchangeable on these services. Also on Tuesdays Cumbria Classic Coaches runs the 574 service

from Kirkby Stephen to Penrith via Appleby and Kirkby Thore. FEVPT are still needing a representative from Temple Sowerby to attend 5 short meetings a year.
